We All Love Music!

Music has the power to make us feel lively, depressed, relaxed or happy. Research into the effect music has on living things gives us some surprising results.

So, how does music affect young people? Teenagers who listened to lively, upbeat music when they did homework were in a better mood, so their marks improved! Classical music at school helped school children relax and concentrate more on their work. And that's not all! Teenagers who took music classes were more sociable and creative, not to mention better at Maths. That's a great reason to start learning to play a musical instrument, don't you think?

Does it surprise you that animals like music, too? Researchers discovered that horses moved in time to the rhythm of the music they listened to. That's almost like dancing! And dogs slept more and barked less when they listened to classical music, but heavy metal music made them bark a lot and even shake! Heavy metal fans, be careful! And did you know that cows produce more milk when they listen to classical music? Ah, music, wonderful moo-sic!

What about plants? They're living things, too! Researchers found that playing classical music in a rice field made the rice grow faster. The wheat in some wheat fields in Canada seemed to like violin music - farmers produced over 60% more wheat than usual. That's amazing!

UNDERSTANDING THE FUNCTION: UNDERSTANDING THE SPEAKER'S STANCE

Listening Skill 3: Understanding the Function

Function questions require you to listen to part of a conversation or lecture from the passage again, and then you will be asked to determine the function of or the purpose for a smaller portion that is repeated. This type of question is not asking you for the general topic or main idea of what the speaker said, but rather is asking you why the speaker said something.

The functions of what is said in this type of reply question include the following:

- to apologize
- to ask for or add more information
- to change the subject
- to clarify or make a previous statement clearer
- to complain
- to interrupt
- to make a suggestion or a recommendation

In addition, some of the questions will ask you what was implied when the speaker used a certain expression or answered a question in a specific way. In other words, you will need to understand the speaker's purpose when it is not directly stated.

The following are examples of this type of question:

Listen again to part of the conversation. Then answer the question. 41

- Why does the speaker say that? 41
- What does the speaker imply when he says that? 41
- What is the purpose of the speaker's request? 41

Note that the [41] icon indicates that part of the conversation or lecture will be repeated. You will not see this part of the conversation or lecture on the computer screen.

In order to answer the question correctly, you must listen closely and understand who the speakers are, where they are, and what is happening in the context of the conversation or lecture. You must then figure out the speaker's purpose or reason based on the context.

EXPRESS TIP

It is common for people to say something that sounds like a statement of fact when actually they have another purpose for saying it. For example, a woman says this to her roommate:
Woman: Hey, Susan, I find the people in the next apartment can probably hear your music.
It is likely that the woman is not saying this to inform Susan that the neighbors can hear her music. The real purpose is to get Susan to turn down the volume because it is too loud. Therefore, you must learn to listen not just to the words that are spoken, but to what they actually mean in any particular situation. Tone of voice can provide additional clues.

Look at this example of function question on a computer screen. First, you will see some images and hear a lecture, discussion, or conversation.

EXAMPLE: Function Question

Man: Don't ask! I'll be lucky if I don't fail the whole course.
